CY9C - St. Paul Is.

The CY9C team is grateful to FlexRadio, Inc. for the loan of six complete FlexRadio station set-ups which include a FLEX-6600 transceiver, MaestroTM control head, and a Power Genius (PGXL) amplifier.

A seventh FLEX-6700 station will be used for VHF/UHF/EME and satellite. Each station will have its own Honda EU2200i generator. There will be three operating teams whose schedule will slowly rotate through the gray line, so everyone experiences all the propagation. Half of the radios will be used for CW, SSB & DIGITAL modes. At any given time, a minimum of three stations will be using the new SuperFox FT8 mode.



K8R - American Samoa



From July 7 – 22, look for K8R to again be active from American Samoa, primarily testing out all systems on all bands; CW, SSB and FT8 ahead of the Jarvis Island DXpedition. Also participation in the IARU contest. Actual signal reports will be appreciated, says George AA7JV.

Super Fox Mode



1. What is SuperFox mode in WSJT-X?

SuperFox mode allows an expedition to make digital QSOs at rates higher than possible with previous versions of WSJT-X. In previous versions the Fox would transmit up to 5 streams, with each stream being 50 Hz wide.

The SuperFox transmits a full power constantenvelope waveform 1512 Hz wide. The SuperFox may send reports or RR73s to as many as nine SuperHounds simultaneously. Importantly there is no reduction in received signal strength to do so. A SuperHound will experience the same received signal strength regardless of the number of Hounds being contacted by the SuperFox.

In addition, the SuperFox transmits a digital signature of authenticity. This signature allows the SuperHound to verify the legitimacy of the expedition, thereby reducing or eliminating piracy. This is covered in more detail soon.

2. Do I need special software?

Yes, both the SuperFox and SuperHound need to run WSJT-X version 2.7.0-RC5 or newer. (expect the release around July 1).

Bags are packed and ready. I decided to bring enough fiberglass mast material to try to get on the low bands so there will be a chance of working 80m and 160m. No bag over 45 lbs. Enough gear for decent station, K3, KPA, KAT, KX3 two Spiderbeam telescope masts, and coax and radials for the station — and everything else that goes in between.

All operations will be split except for FT-8 which will be traditional F/H mode. Super-Fox-Hound will not be used. SA, AF and OC have priority regardless of who I am CQing, otherwise if I call JA, NA or EU try to listen for your turn. Again, always work split, and up. Update your Logging Software (it has been several weeks since the COUNTRY file has been updated so that the QSO will log correctly in your Software as Lord Howe Island).

6M Frustration

Frank, W3LPL states:

If you've been active on 6 meters this season, you've noticed shorter duration and infrequent 6 meter sporadic-E openings extending beyond 2000 km.

Last year was almost as bad, as were 2012 and 2013.

Sporadic-E is caused by vertical wind-shears in the lower thermosphere. Unlike lower altitudes in the atmosphere, the thermosphere is greatly affected by the solar cycle apparently causing anomalies in its wind field and a corresponding reduction in the frequency, intensity and geographic extent of vertical wind shears associated with sporadic-E formation.


Sporadic-E probably won't get much better for a few years. Its the price we pay for a more active solar maximum


