


From the Desk of the Editor

Team 6O3T now have dates for their DXpedition: September 9-30, 2024. The location will be in the northern part of the country in the state of Somaliland. Special focus on low bands and 6m; SSB, CW & Digi.

Somaliland is one of the 5 states that make up the defacto country called Somalia. A difficult territory that has never been spared from war and famine. An exciting and complicated DXpedition, in a turbulent territory, and not always easy to activate.

The Magnet, with the N5J team and three USFWS scientists on board, got under way at 0500 AM from American Samoa for Jarvis island. The time required to cover the distance of 1050 Nautical Miles (1940 km) depends on the boat-speed that we are able to maintain. Currently we are cruising at 15 knots (27 kmph) in light winds and moderate seas (waves of 3 to 5 feet). According to the forecast this favorable weather should continue for the next three days. Although we are likely to encounter some opposing currents, we expect to arrive at Jarvis the morning of August 6. If for some some reason we need to slow down, we will time our arrival for the morning of the 7th

KH8T - USA Samoa

N5DD, W5MJ, K5PI, VE7KW will be operating from American Samoa as KH8T, OC-045 during September 2-16, 2024.

Plans include 2 stations for all bands 80 through 10, CW, SSB, and FT8, including SuperFox mode. Possibly 160m, 60m and 6m if antennas and propagation allow. Equipment includes two K3, FTDX10, Expert 1.3K, Expert 1.5K, two Hexbeams, half squares, and verticals.

S9Z - Sao Tome

NCDXF is pleased to announce its financial support for the S9Z Sao Tome DXpedition for their inclusion of a young DXer, Angus Alexander, KJ7KOJ. This will be Angus' first chance at being a DXpeditioner. He is a great operator and has the full support of his Dad, Robin, W7YED who is also on the team. The S9Z team is led by Tom, N4XP and has an experienced team of operators. The operation takes place in mid-November 2024.

HK0 - Malpelo

Last active in 2012 (by HK0NA who still maintain the 2nd highest ever QSO count for a DXpedition), the Colombian League of Radio Amateurs (HK3LR) and its Board of Directors has announced its main goal – to stage a DXpedition to Malpelo island, SA-007. It is hoped for a February 2026 activity, but this is not yet confirmed.


CY9C - St Paul Is.

The CY9C DXpedition team confirmed with Breton Air on Tuesday that the airlift of infrastructure gear over to the Northeast Island of St Paul will take place on Saturday, August 24. Six airlifts are currently planned and the airlifts will be taking the tents, tables, chairs, generators, fuel, electrical cables, coaxial cables and all other necessary gear to build the CY9C camp. As with most DXpeditions, weather will play a factor in the schedule. Preparations for the airlift will commence on Monday, August 5, with the arrival of the first load of gear in Dingwall. The estimated cost of just the helicopter airlifts is \$48,300 Canadian. Any support to help with this expense will be greatly appreciated. The CY9C team members are excited and have completed packing their personal gear for the trip.

Solar News

SUNSPOT COUNTS HIT A 23-YEAR HIGH: The sun is partying like it's 2001. That's the last time sunspot counts were as high as they are now. The monthly average sunspot number for July 2024 was 196.5, according to the Royal Observatory of Belgium's <u>Solar Influences Data Analysis Center</u>. This eclipses every month since Dec. 2001:




Solar Cycle 25 wasn't expected to be this strong. When it began in Dec. 2019, experts predicted it would be a weak cycle like its immediate predecessor Solar Cycle 24. If that forecast had panned out, Solar Cycle 25 would be one of the weakest solar cycles in a century.


Instead, Solar Cycle 25 has shot past Solar Cycle 24 and may be on pace to rival some of the stronger cycles of the 20th century. Already in May 2024 we have experienced <u>a century-class geomagnetic storm</u> with auro-

ras sighted in the South Pacific, central America and south Africa.

The last time sunspot numbers were this high, the sun was on the verge of launching the Great Halloween Storms of 2003, which included the strongest X-ray solar flare ever recorded (X45) and a CME so powerful it was ultimately detected by the Voyager spacecraft at the edge of the solar system.



Is this Solar Max? The jury is still out. Sunspot numbers may continue to rise in the months ahead and, based on the behavior of previous cycles, we can confidently expect high solar activity for at least 2 to 3 more years.


FP - Miquelon Is.

The sun's next solar cycle has begun, 'starquakes' suggest

The current 11-year solar cycle hasn't even finished yet, and the next is beginning!

Solar scientists have spotted indications that the next solar cycle is beginning. That is despite the fact that it isn't due for another six years, and the current solar cycle (Cycle 25) is still in progress.

The current solar cycle is expected to reach its peak or "solar maximum" midway through 2025 when the magnetic field of our star will flip and its poles will switch. Leading up to this solar activity has been ramping up with an increase in sunspots, solar flares and eruptions of stellar plasma called coronal mass ejections (CMEs).




