
7O2WX - Yemen

A3 - Tonga





ERT ÞÚ QRV Á 160 METRUM?

Ef ekki, þá er rétti tíminn að bæta úr því núna, í tæka tíð fyrir fjórðu TF útileikana um verzlunarmannahelgina nú í sumar. 160 metra bandið gefur nýja og lítt kannaða möguleika til sambanda um langar vegalengdir innanlands. Útileikarnir eru kjörið tækifæri til að kanna útbreiðsluna milli staða, sem radióamatörar heimsækja ekki á hverjum legi. Hin langa bylgjulengd gerir það að verkum, að jarðbylgjan dregur lengra en á nokkru öðru amatörbandi. Möguleikar á áreiðanlegu sambandi eru fyrir hendi þar sem önnur bönd kunna að vera ónothæf. Áhugavert væri t.d. með hliðsjón af suðurlands-skjálftanum, að athuga hve langt jarðbylgjan dregur frá Reykjavík og um suðurland. Hvernig væri að þú legðir þitt af mörkum með þátttöku í útileikunum?

Á sl. hausti vissu menn, að til staði að amatörar fengju 160 metrana, en ekki hvenær hin formlega tilkynning yrði birt. Það var ekki fyrr en farið var að glugga í nýbirt Stjórnartíðindi, að menn uppgötvaðu, að samgönguráðherra hafði undirritað eftirfarandi reglur þarum einum mánuði áður:

Tíðni stöðvanna, útgeislun og afl eru samkvæmt eftirfarandi töflu:

Útsendingar í þessu tíðnisviði skulu fyrst um sinn vera í formi tilraunasendinga og má rakstraumsafl inn á útgangsstig ekki fara fram úr 50 W.

Hvaða tæki og hvaða loftnet er spurning, sem allir velta fyrir sér, hvort sem menn nota bandið nú þegar, eða ráðgera það á næstunni. Sum heimilistæki (þau sem kallast transceiverar) hafa bandið nú þegar og er vandinn þá ekki mikill, nema ef til vill sá að fá afl út úr tækinu á löglegu inngangsafl. Þurft getur að breyta forspennu á útgangsstiginu til að nýtnin sé ofan við núllið. Þetta er allt í lagi á CW, en getur komið niður á mótun og bandbreidd á SSB. Ýmsir freistandi smíðamöguleikar eru fyrir hendi og hafa birt góðar hugmyndir í blöðum t.d. Practical Wireless auk þess, sem borið hefur á góma í viðræðum anatöra á meðal. Viðráðanleikinn ætti að vera góður sökum lágrar tíðni.

Við fastastöðvar hýtur loftnetið í flestum tilvikum að vera einhverskonar langur vir. Jarðbylgjan er lóðrétt póluð og gagnstætt útbreiddum miskilningi geislar hún mest út til endanna á virnum. Það stafar af nálægt loftnetsins við jörð. Larétt pólaða bylgjan geislar hinsvegar til hliðanna, en hún er betur fallin sem háloftabylgja. Nokkur góð ráð er að finna í grein TF3DX inni í blaðinu.
